Job duties for ATC

- Assist with physicals for all FNU sports teams for assigned dates
- Primary AT for FNU Women's volleyball, Men's soccer and Men's basketball teams. Home game coverage, including arriving an hour before competition for pre-game taping/bracing, stretching, set up. Home game times vary. Schedule provided at beginning of season.
- Maintain professional communication with AD and coaches including prompt notification of player status with injury reports.
- Organize and deliver treatments and rehabilitation 3 days per week for 3 hours each for all athletes at Bucky Dent Rec Center in Hialeah. The treatment times are tentatively scheduled for 10-1 pm for the fall semester on M, W, & F. We are flexible on treatment hours depending on the AT's schedule.
- Injury prevention program description and implementation for all teams.
- Maintain accurate and up to date medical documentation for all athletes.
- Appropriate medical referrals and fill out all according forms.
- Maintain accurate and prompt documentation for all injuries, treatment, rehabilitation and referrals.
- Attendance to weekly athletic department meetings as necessary.
